St. Elizabeth's Hospital Laboratory is accredited by the College of American Pathologists (CAP), and is licensed by CMS. Procedures available at the O'Fallon location include:

- Blood bank
- Chemistry
- Cytology
- Hematology

- Microbiology

- Serology
- Urinalysis

In addition to lab services, the O'Fallon Medical Building also includes UrgiCare Services, imaging services such as CT, X-ray, mammograms and an open MRI, family physician offices, physical therapy, and cosmetic and reconstructive surgery clinic hours.
