Breast Health Awareness

KNOW YOUR BREAST CANCER RISKS:

St. Elizabeth's encourages women age 40 and over to learn about their risks now and make an appointment to be screened today. Women can answer nine assessment questions to know their risk of breast cancer:

- Do you have a family history of breast cancer?
- Do you have a personal history of breast cancer?
- Did your period begin before age 12?
- Have you gone through menopause?
- Are you overweight?
- Do you drink alcohol every day?
- Have you never had children, or did you have your first child after age 30?
- Do you have excess fat around your waist?
- Have you ever taken hormone replacement therapy?

If the answer is YES to any of these questions, results indicate an increased risk of breast cancer. The more YES responses, the greater the risk. Women are encouraged to talk to their doctor about breast cancer risks at their next appointment.
